



Parents/guardians are to conduct the following screening with their children each day prior to sending them to an athletic contest or practice. If a student's answer to this cluster of symptoms or any specific symptom within the cluster is “yes” and they cannot be explained by any other cause and/or your child has a temperature above 99.6 degrees F, do not send them to athletics. We ask that parents use their discretion if symptoms are related to something else (i.e. allergies)

Fever (above 99.6 degrees F)

Cough

Sore Throat

Shortness of Breath

Please contact the coach and let them know your child will not be attending if you suspect the symptoms are related to COVID-19 or if your child has a temperature above 99.6 degrees F. You are then required to provide a note from a medical doctor prior to them returning to participation.

If you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 we ask that you immediately contact the Medina County Health Department at 330-723-9688 for medical advice on how to proceed. Do not attend any athletic contest or practice until you have received and followed their recommendation. Please keep your coach updated, and also provide a note from your medical provider or the Health Department upon your return.
